



CRACKSEC Installation Instructions

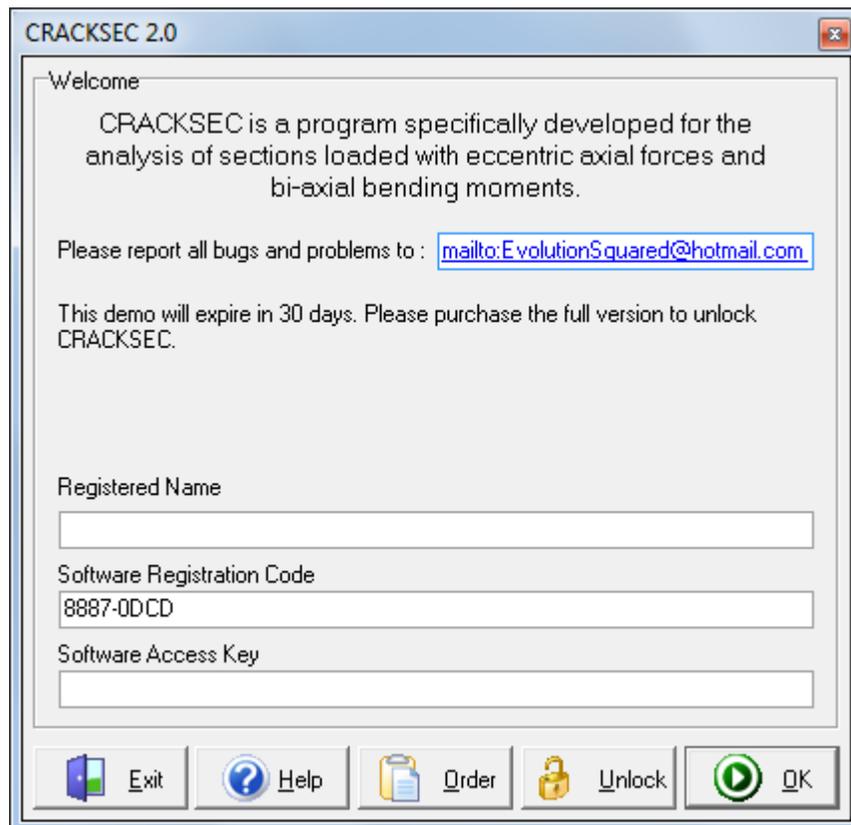
The user must have Administrator privileges on the PC to install CRACKSEC. The software can only be installed and run in stand-alone mode – a network version is not available.

CRACKSEC has been tested on both x64 and x86 processors and the latest version can be found on the ACES website at: www.aces-systems.com

Installation

1. Run the installation application called "*Cracksec-V2.XXXXX-Setup.exe*" on the PC you wish to install CRACKSEC on. The program cannot be run over a network.
2. Click the *Next* button then read and accept the licence agreement.
3. The default install location is "*C:\Program Files (x86)\Aces Analysis Systems\Cracksec*". You may change the location by selecting the "*Change..*" button.
4. After (optionally) changing the location click the *Next* button followed by the "*Install*" button.
5. The process is now complete.
6. If you wish to run CRACKSEC select the "*Launch*" check box and click "*Finish*".

7. When CRACKSEC starts for the first time it will require an activation key. A registration dialog box as shown below will be displayed allowing this key to be entered. If an activation key is not entered a 30 day demonstration/evaluation period will come into effect.
8. To register CRACKSEC and permanently unlock it email the software registration code (or a screen dump of the registration dialog box) to AAS at: aces@internode.on.net
9. If the program has already been purchased a software access key will be provided, permanently unlocking CRACKSEC. This key is *only* valid for the PC or laptop onto which CRACKSEC has been installed. It cannot be moved to another machine.
